

SCRAP METAL

Beyond the Swap Shop, **M**, on the left there is a spot for miscellaneous metal items, **G**.

WHITE GOODS

Across the tarmac from the Swap Shop discard major appliances with metal shells, **H**. Some items will incur a fee; check with the dump attendant, **Q**.

AUTOMOTIVE WASTE

Wheels, rims, old jacks and other all-metal pieces go on the metal pile, **G**. Batteries, used motor oil and oil filters, tires, etc. **I**. Dump attendants, **Q**, will show you where they go and collect a small fee for some. Recycle used or leftover antifreeze free at Fay's Automotive Center, 45 Court Street in Provincetown.

WE ALSO TAKE


Leaves—on the compost pile **K**, no brush or bags. Scrap lead, copper, brass, bronze, and other dense metals, **G**. NiCad rechargeable and button batteries **I**, and corks, **E**. See attendants if you need guidance. Cathode ray tubes (TV screens and computer monitors), flat LED and plasma screens all go into a special trailer for recycling, **L**; pay a fee to the attendant, **Q**. For silent switches, glass clinical thermometers, fluorescent tubes & compact bulbs and other waste containing mercury, see attendant, **Q**.

SWAP SHOP

Truro's Free Store—give to and take from it all sorts of usable items like tools, toys, clothing, shoes, kitchen equipment, books, magazines and small appliances in working order. Everything you leave must be clean and in good condition, **M**.

A dump sticker is required to dispose of waste in the tip, **N**.

RECYCLING IN TRURO

Truro Transfer Station is on the east side of Route 6 between mile markers 105 & 106

You do not need a dump sticker to recycle!

Please *rinse everything* before you leave it

DEPOSIT BOTTLES AND CANS

Plastic bottles and metal cans go into boxes in the trailer near exit at right, **A**. Put glass bottles in the wooden bin near the tables for recyclables, **B**.

OTHER GLASS CONTAINERS

Remove metal caps, rings and foil or plastic wrappings. All colors into marked boxes, **C**. Please put all broken glass, window glass, light bulbs, drinking glasses and mirrors into the trash tip.

METAL CANS

Flattened aluminum and steel ("tin") cans, empty aerosol cans, pie plates, foil, etc. with plastics on the table, **D**. Put empty paint cans on the metal pile, **G**. Take usable residues of paint to special shack, **O**.

PLASTIC ITEMS

Any clean plastic except film (bags) and styrofoam, **D**. Take plastic bags to supermarkets for recycling.

CDS AND DVDS

If playable, box in Swap Shop. Others go into marked bucket in newspaper shack, **E**.

PAPER

Clean newspapers in stacks or in paper bags (no plastic bags or string), all other dry paper and pasteboard, glossy inserts from newspapers, junk mail, office paper, magazines, paperbacks not wanted at the Swap Shop, phone books, wrapping paper, cardboard tubes and wax-coated, square milk and juice cartons if they have plastic spouts with screw-on caps, **E**. No greasy paper or cardboard, none coated with wax or plastic, or any paper box or wrapping that goes into a freezer. Please compost any food-soiled paper, **K**.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Please flatten and put in the box in the back of the paper shack, **F**.
