Truro Recreation Youth Sports are for children that reside in Truro or attend Truro Central School. Our programs are designed to encourage developmental skills, teamwork, and social bonds.

YOUTH BASKETBALL Grades K - 6

Basketball practices will begin in December and games begin in January. The boy's games will be played on Wednesday evenings and the girl's games will be played on Monday evenings.

Children in grades K-2 will generally practice once a week at TCS or TCC.

Children in grades 3-6 will practice once or twice a week depending on the team and scheduling availability. They will have one game per week and will often have to travel to other towns for those games. Home games and practices will be held at TCS.

YOUTH CHEERLEADING Grades 1-6

Cheer generally practices 1-2 times per week and cheer at Truro Recreation home basketball games (Mondays & Wednesdays.) Cheer game schedules are dictated by the size and make up of the group. We try our best to accommodate cheerleaders who play Truro Recreation basketball as well, so that schedules allow them to participate in both sports. In some cases, this may not be possible, however, due to facility availability.
