In the mean time, we have merchandise available for sale. Please keep us in mind when you are shopping for the holidays. These sales help support the THS during the off season.



Original nude practice sketches by Courtney Allen

As one of the original founders and first president of the Truro Historical Society, Courtney Allen (1898-1969), known worldwide as an artist and a sculptor, gifted the THS with his lifetime collection of practice sketches which document the evolution of his talents and techniques. View this specially selected collection of nude sketches dating from 1919 through 1967. It was his wish that this collection be used as a fund-raising tool for the Society.

A limited number of these beautiful works of art will be for sale to the public during the off-season months. The sketches are backed on acid-free core-board and protected by an acid-free plastic sleeve. Each sketch includes documentation from the Truro Historical Society establishing it as a Courtney Allen original. Male and female sketches are available. **Prices range from \$100 - \$125 - \$150 (plus tax.)** This is an opportunity to own an original piece of historical artwork at an unbelievably low price.
