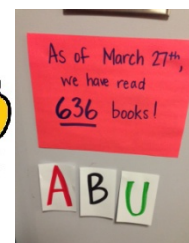
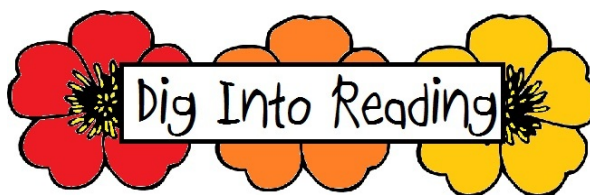
Dig Into Reading

It's time for the annual T.C.S. Reading Challenge. This event encourages school-wide reading each March through May, and this year, the theme is "Dig Into Reading". It's inspired by our school initiative to think about growing local — in our raised garden beds and through our popular Farm-to-School lunch program.

Our goal is to read 1,000 books by the end of May. All T.C.S. students and staff are encouraged to participate — and participation is easy and fun! Start by reading a book and then tell an adult about it. Fill in a petal on a flower that helps you chart your progress. When you have filled up a flower (4 petals), bring it to school. You get to "dig" around in a giant box of polished gemstones and put it into a personalized pouch. Read more books, collect more gemstones. If we reach the 1,000 book goal, there will be a special all-school prize. Clues to the identity of the all-school prize are revealed after each 200 books.
