CAPE COD NATIONAL SEASHORE WALK: SEAL SCOUT - 1½ hours, 1 to 2 miles in loose sand. Join a ranger for an exciting opportunity to look for seals at a Truro beach. CAPE COD NATIONAL SEASHORE HIKE: OFF THE BEATEN PATH — Up to 2 hours, 2 miles, moderate difficulty. Terrain can include steep hills and loose sand. Wear or bring long pants, shoes appropriate for walking in loose sand, sunscreen, bug spray and water. Ascend Bearberry Hill for dramatic views of the ocean and the Pamet River Valley. Along the way, experience multiple habitats of heathlands, forest, and sea cliffs. *Directions:* Take Truro Center/Pamet Roads exit off Route 6 in Truro. Proceed 1½ miles on North Pamet Road to the end. Meet at the parking area adjacent to the Environmental Education Center (a hostel in summer). Saturdays, June 6, June 13 at 9AM

CAPE COD NATIONAL SEASHORE WALK: DUNE VIEWS OVER EAST HARBOR - 1½ hours, 1½ miles in loose sand. Moderate difficulty. Terrain can include steep hills and loose sand. Wear or bring long pants, shoes appropriate for walking in loose sand, sunscreen, bug spray and water. Climb atop a parabolic dune to gain 360° views of ocean, cranberry bogs, harbor, and Provincetown. Discover the story of how the harbor was turned into a "lake", then back into a harbor. Meet in the bike trail parking lot at the end of High Head Road, off Route 6, in Truro (stay left and continue on the dirt road). Thursdays, June 4, June 11 at 10AM
