

# TRURO SOLAR FARM

## Residential Participation Introduction

The Truro Solar Farm developer, SunEdison, is planning on leasing enough land from the Town at the Truro landfill to build a 1,145 kilowatt (kW) solar system. The Town buildings will use about 500 kW of that capacity and be the “anchor tenant” of the project.

The remaining solar capacity, about 645 kW, will be available to residential customers under a “Community Solar” program operated by SunEdison.

SunEdison has agreed to give priority to qualified homeowners in Truro for a limited period of time, before offering it to other customers. Residential customers will be able to use the solar output of the Truro Solar Farm to offset their Eversource electricity usage. That will end up saving about 10% on the portion of the electric bill that is offset by solar.
