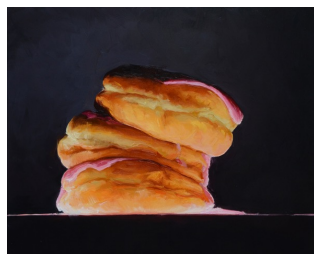
While it may cold and grey on Cape Cod, why not look forward to the regrowth that is to come and expand your creativity this spring and summer with a workshop or two?
